As uniforms are an integral component of any public safety program, the awards emphasize the importance of professional, neat, well fitted, and immediately identifiable uniforms in police, fire and other first-responder public safety programs.

“There are many contributing factors to excellence in a public safety uniform program,” said Richard Lerman, president and CEO of the NAUMD. “Its design, composition, durability and overall comfort all affect how well the individuals who protect us are able to remain safe while executing their sometimes dangerous responsibilities. Judging Criteria:

Submissions are judged by a set of criteria designed to recognize excellence in the development and design of the multi-faceted programs required by 21st century Police Agencies

- **Overall design excellence of the Uniform Program**
- **Innovative design for use within the environment and special conditions in which the uniforms must be worn.**
- **Effectiveness in meeting the image goals of the Department and Teams within the Department (i.e., SWAT Team, Special Services, etc.),**
- **Innovative use of fabric, design and accessories to develop a uniform image most fitting the Department & Town’s requirements.**
- **Overall attractiveness of the entire program**
- **Effectiveness in design in the Identification of each Team within the Department for the Public and other Government agencies.**

About the winners and their winning programs:

Under 50 Officers: RED THE UNIFORM TAILOR FOR OLD SAYBROOK POLICE DEPARTMENT!

Goals were set by the Department’s Uniform Enhancement Committee to create a new uniform that was safer, more professional, contemporary, unique and that would allow the officers to have even more pride in their appearance. The committee had significant challenges in funding and general design. But once implemented the program dramatically improved moral and assisted the new Chief to establish a new and enthusiastic culture for the Agency.

Sheriffs Department: NYE UNIFORMS FOR ROSCOMMON SHERIFFS DEPARTMENT

The goal for the Roscommon Sheriff Dept was to uniform all Law Enforcement Officers with Dress Coats for public appearances. The biggest obstacle was the funding. This goal was accomplished this year. Our future goal is to equip all corrections officers with a dress coat.

State Agency: FECHHEIMER FOR CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL

The goal for the new uniform program was to establish easily identifiable and perfectly suited to the officer's duties all the while conveying a positive and professional image to the public. We also paid significant attention to climate and assignment realities in all we did!

Specialized Agency: GALLS ARAMARK FOR US MINT POLICE

The Mint Police had not implemented a new uniform program in some time. They have as such attempted to streamline the uniform process by having uniform quartermasters at each Mint facility to meet the needs of officers as well as a central uniform coordinator at headquarters. The Chief has also established a Uniform Committee consisting of one member from each Mint facility and a member of upper management to review uniform suggestions, make recommendations and evaluate issue items.

Special Organization: PERFECTION UNIFORMS FOR WEST VIRGINIA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION

Appearance is a key component of, and reason for, the statewide changeover. This was reached through the hard work of committee development & sheriff's/governor's office consensus. Use for within environment/special conditions; image goals of not only departments but also teams within departments; fabric, design and accessories; attractiveness; comfort; quality; development of first time uniform consistency in state of West Virginia.

Increased recognition for our department and our investment in uniforms and equipment standards that reflect well on our organization. Uniform standards are specified in a general order. All uniforms are required to be properly fit, neat, clean and pressed.
